Salvage operations are not new to Ee-Jay as we have been evacuating derailed cars and damaged tanks and silos since our very inception. The August 1, 2007 catastrophic and tragic interstate bridge collapse in Minneapolis has again challenged us to implement innovative approaches consistent with safety and caution as we take steps to protect and extract damaged property.
